Respect in Sport Policy - Saskatchewan Squash Purpose of the Policy: Saskatchewan Squash is committed to creating a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity. Coaches have a responsibility to create a sporting environment that is free of harassment, abuse, bullying and neglect. Saskatchewan Squash requires that all coaches participating in squash have completed the online Respect in Sport (RiS) certification (or equivalency), as required by Scope and Application: 1. The policy applies to all Sask Sport Inc. coaches registered or named on an official sport roster under the membership jurisdiction of Saskatchewan Squash. 2. Coaches not holding valid certification will have until Aug. 31 each year to complete the RiS certification training or training equivalency such as NCCP Empower + or Respect in School program. 3. Saskatchewan Squash is responsible for setting out the communication strategy specific to the certification requirements and deadline. Enforcement: Any coach not having RiS certification (or equivalency) by the deadline established will be removed as a coach until such time that the course is completed. • Non-compliance with this policy may result in further discipline as determined by the Board of Directors or in accordance with Saskatchewan Squash policy. RiS Administration: The Executive Director of Saskatchewan Squash will have administrative access to the RiS database to oversee functions such as report generation and Review and Approval: This policy was approved by the monitoring. Saskatchewan Squash Board of Directors on March 26, 2013 and will be reviewed by the Executive Committee on an annual basis.
